



Selecting

Emergency Care



Trauma

Hamilton Medical Center Emergency Department treats traumatic injuries resulting from athletics, car accidents, and natural disasters.



Stitches

Hamilton Convenient Care helps care for lacerations, cuts and other injuries that require prompt medical attention but are not emergencies. No appointment necessary with weekend availability!



X-Rays

Hamilton Convenient Care treats muscle strains, joint sprains and fractures with on-site x-rays. If patients are in need of further medical attention, Convenient Care makes referrals to the Emergency Department or area physicians.



Transportation

If you are unable to travel to Hamilton's Emergency Department due to severe injury or illness, call 9-1-1 and an ambulance will be dispatched to your location.



After Hours
